They are trying to develop a Disc Golf Team and would like to promote the sport on campus. What started out as a seminar has, thanks to the PDGA, also become a benefit for the Hurricane Relief Fund. We will probably run a putting contest and CTP during lunch. We might also have a raffle. Sign-ups start at 7 AM with tee-off at 8.30. C-tier events have a \$2 player fee, but I've raised it to \$5 to raise more money.
